**English/Language Arts/Reading:** We are beginning to analyze non-fiction text by reading a variety of non-fiction books. After analyzing this genre, we will study the different text features that enhance the information in the text. We will also determine the main idea and summarize each text.

**Math:** In math we will be completing and testing on Topic 4. Be sure to ask your child how they performed on the assessment. Next we will continue to develop proficiency dividing by 2-digit divisors. Students will be asked to solve for quotients of up to a 4-digit dividend by a 2-digit divisor. It is essential that your child has mastery of their basic facts; otherwise they might make computation errors during this unit of study.

**Science:** In science we are starting our new unit Force, Motion, and Energy.

**Social Studies:** In social studies, we will be learning about reasons for exploring and colonizing new lands. We will also learn the geographic and economic characteristics of each region of the 13 English Colonies, as well as about other early settlements in North America.
