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What's Happening in 5th Grade?

English/Language Arts/Reading: In reading, we will be beginning our drama unit.

Students will read and analyze reader's theater text and compare them to other forms of text. In writing, we will begin our letter writing unit. Students will learn how to write informal and formal letters which contain an opening, important information, and an appropriate closure. Be sure to ask your child what he/she is reading and writing about!

Math: In math we will be wrapping up our study of multiplication and division of fractions-be sure to ask you child how they performed on the topic assessment. Next we will begin our study of algebraic expressions and equations.

Science: As we get back from the Winter Break we will review and wrap-up our Matter Unit in that first week. The students will be taking an end-of-unit test to ensure information was retained. Then we will move into our Ecosystems and Organisms Unit which is usually a student favorite!

Social Studies: We are finishing up our study of events leading to the American Revolution. We will study the major battles of the Revolution as well as the creation of the Declaration of Independence.
